Learn to dive - how does it work in the Diving School Tauchschule Dreiländereck?

The first scuba certification that turns a non-diver into an independent diver is the 1-star\* or OpenWaterDiver OWD certification. These two brevets are absolutely equivalent.

This diving course can be completed *from 15 years* on. It consists of 3 parts, and is of course valid worldwide:

1. Swimming pool: expect around 3-5 lessons depending on how the exercises go.  
These currently take place from mid of May until mid of Septembre every *Wednesday evening* from 6:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. in the outdoor pool in Steinen, or from mid of Septembre until mid of May on *Tuesdays* 8 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. in the indoor pool in Maulburg.
2. A theory day, which repeats in about 2 months rhythm (always on a Saturday). The next one you can find in our diving activities named "*Allgemeine Tauchtheorie*".  
Accompanying the course there is of course a theory book for every diver. Best to be studied before the theory day.
3. Diving in the surrounding Swiss lakes, always on weekends: The diving course is completed with at least 5 dives. You can find the dates also on our website under diving activities, named "*Tauchen & Ausbildung*". We are also happy to do an additional 6<sup>th</sup> dive with you.
4. For *youngsters under 15 years*, the training is equivalent, but they can already record their swimming pool dives in the logbook, and only need 3 dives in the lake to complete the course.  
*Kids from 8-12 years* can complete the whole practice in the swimming pool.

Basically, you come to our appointments when you have time. And you get the time that you personally need for your training, so that you feel safe at diving by the end of the course. The 3-5 lessons and 5-6 dives are only based on our experience.

You can also start your diving training at any time, the theory does not have to be completed BEFORE the swimming pool part.

The first trial lesson = "Schnuppertauchen" costs 25 € plus entry to the swimming pool. If the diving course is then booked with us, we will deduct 100% of the compensation for expenses allowance from the course price of 499 € = €474 €.

The course price for Junior Brevets 1\*, 2\*, J-OWD is 359 €.

If someone registers for two or three, we grant a 10% discount on the course prices

Except for the diver's ABCs, i.e. mask, snorkel, open water fins, gloves and booties, which you would have to buy yourself during the course of the training - but only for the lake dives - all diving equipment is provided free of charge.

You are also welcome to buy these items from us, advantage - you receive a 10% discount on the items and can also test the material in the swimming pool if you are unsure whether they fit.

At the latest for the lake dives we need a *medical certificate* that certifies your suitability for diving. This can be issued, for example, by your family doctor after an appropriate examination. But we can also name various diving doctors in the region who do this simple examination. In principle, we recommend having this examination carried out as soon as possible after the start of the training.
